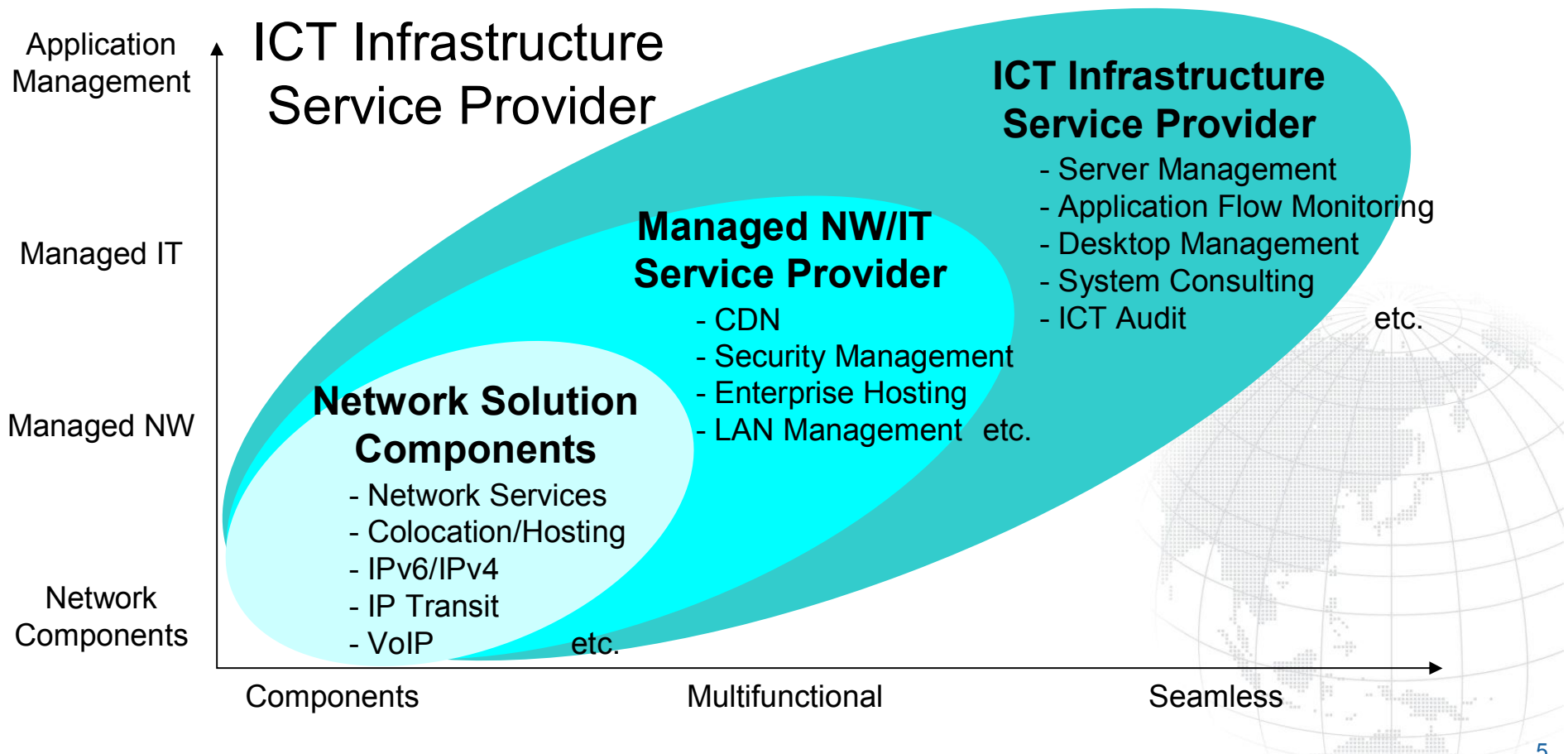

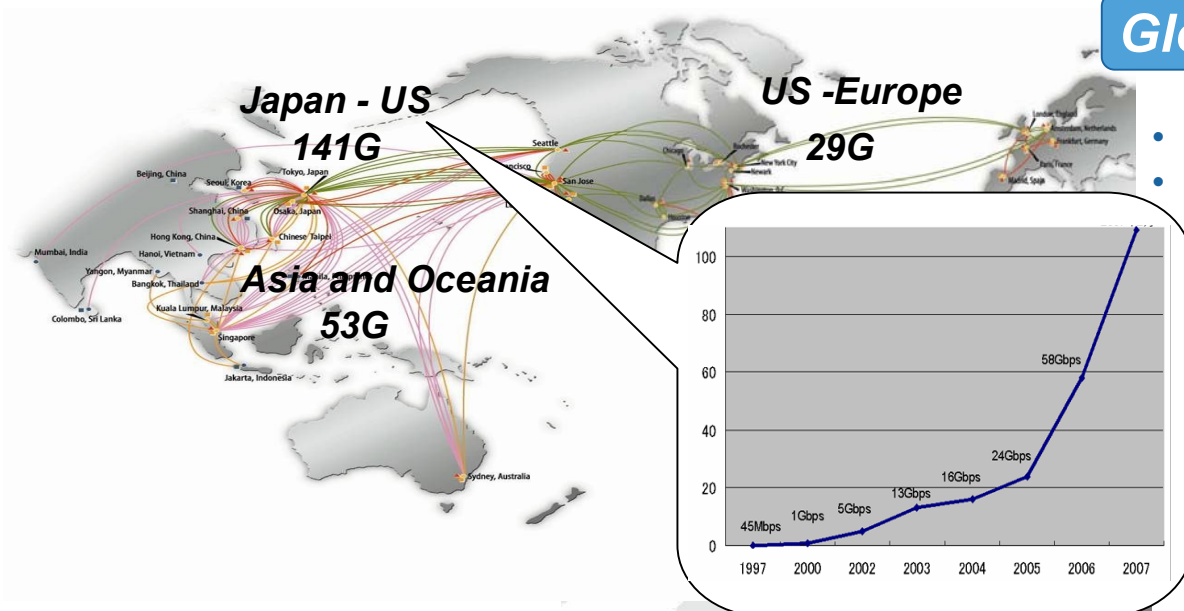
2- (1) Global Business Vision

- Leverage NTTCom's flexible and integrated ICT platform, taking advantage of existing capabilities, including its global network and data centers.



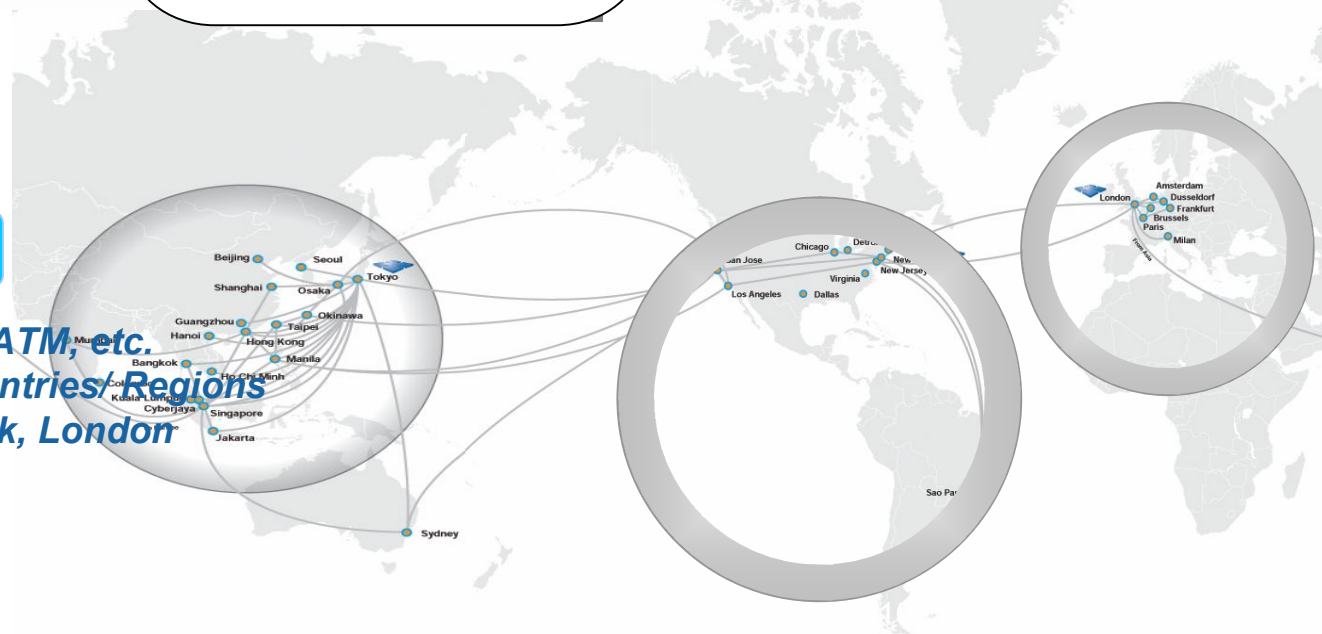
Global IP Backbone Network

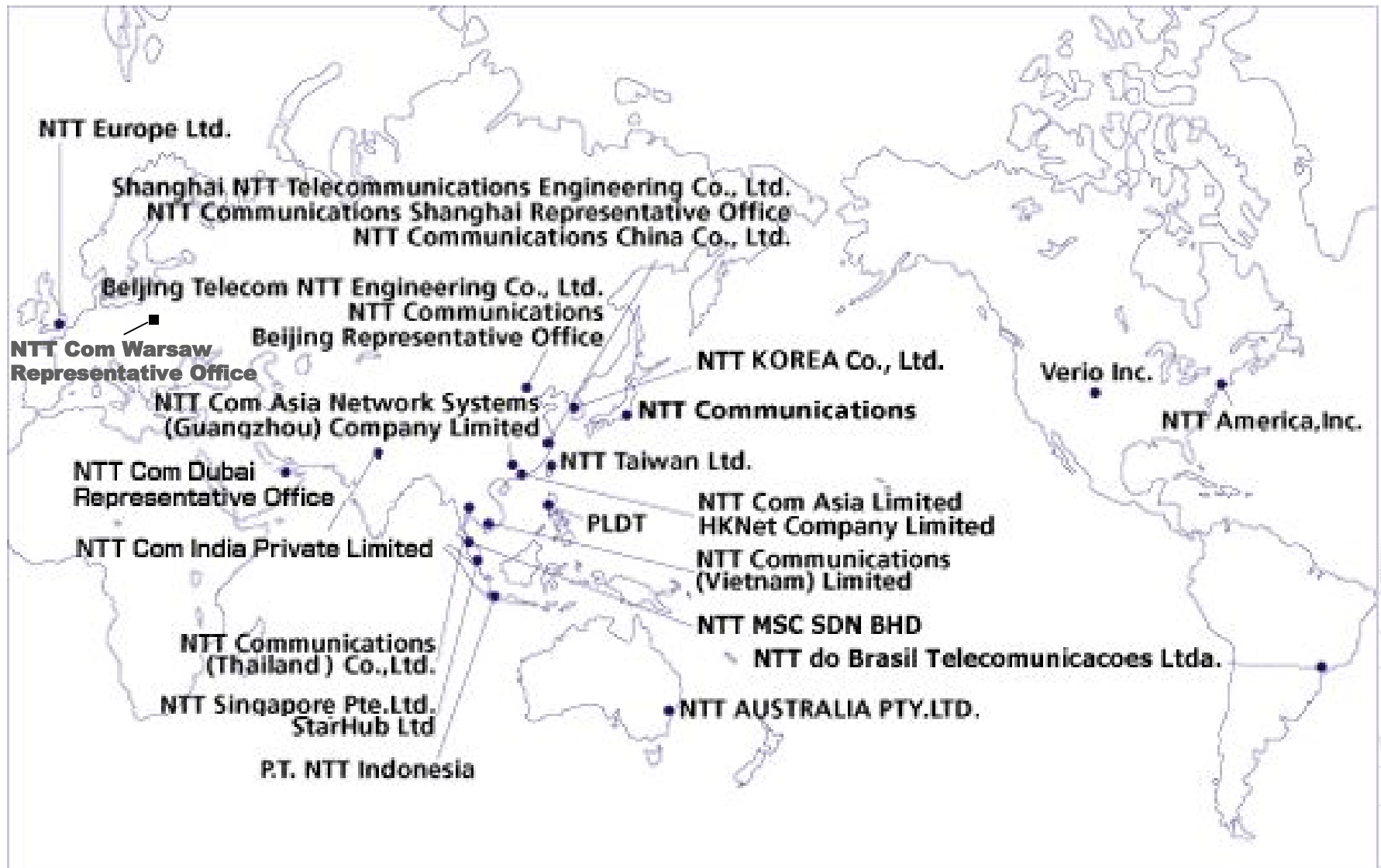

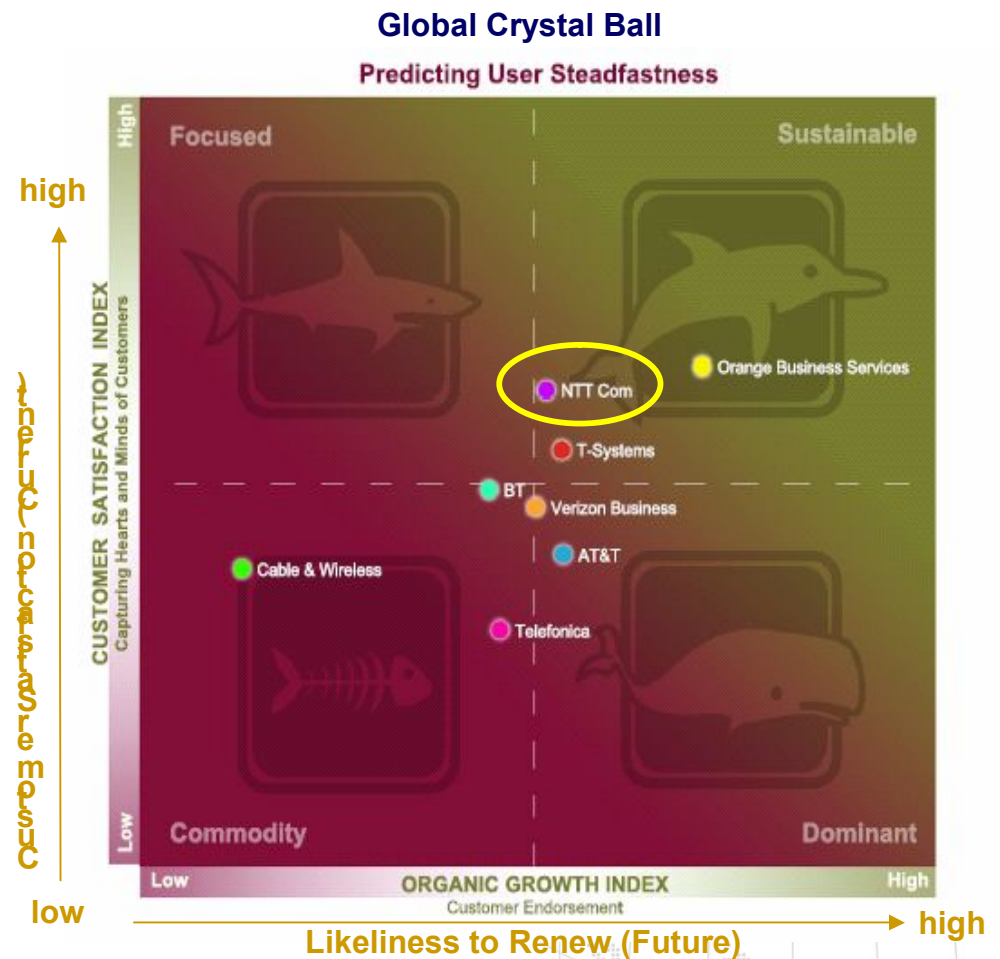

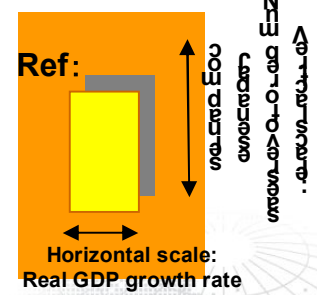

Number of Japanese Companies in Russia



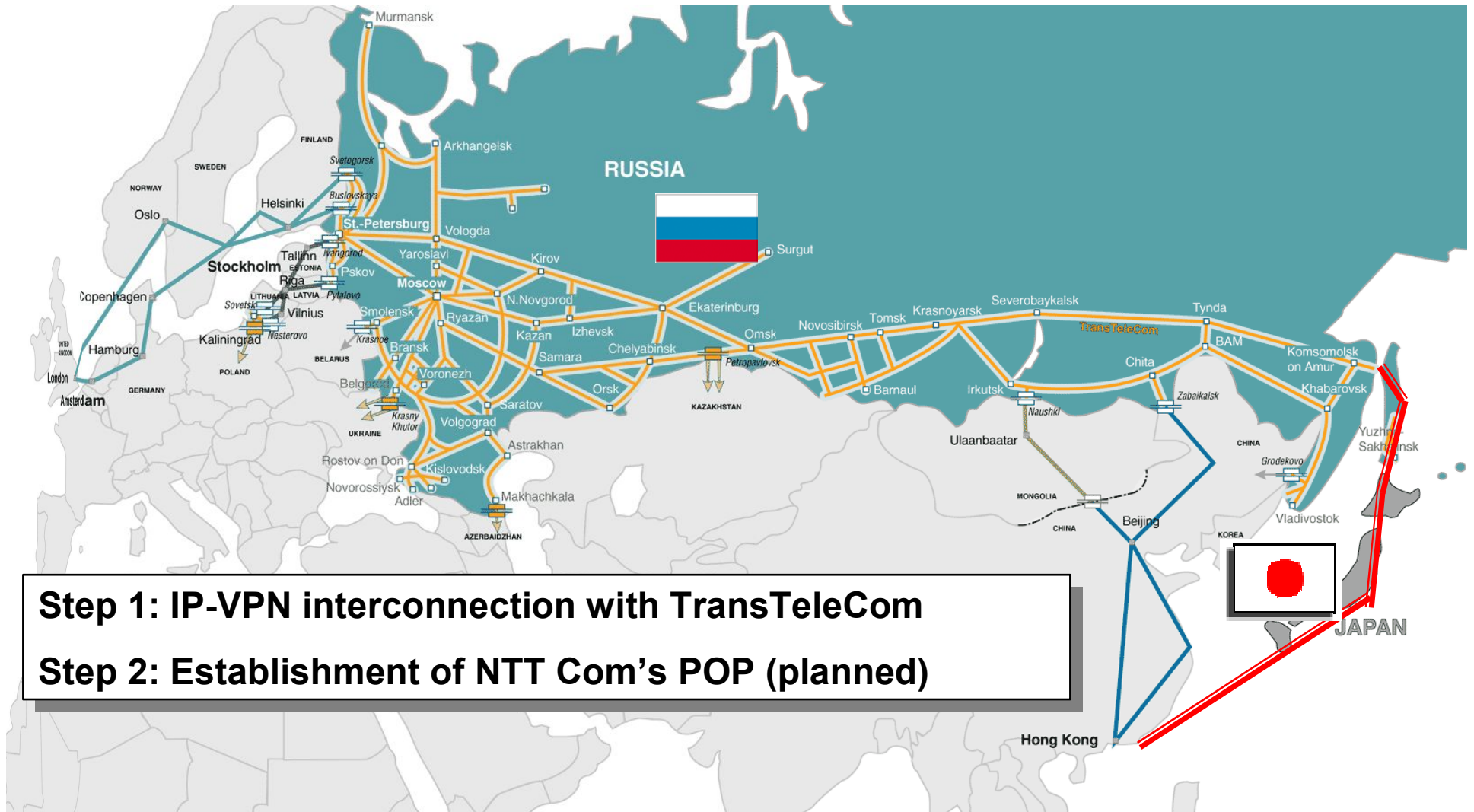

3- (2) Cable construction between Japan and Russia

NTT Com and TransTeleCom is implementing a project of Hokkaido (Japan) – Sakhalin (Russia) cable systems (“HSCS”).



3- (3) Expansion of IP-VPN Network coverage to Russia



Step 1: IP-VPN interconnection with TransTeleCom
Step 2: Establishment of NTT Com's POP (planned)

3- (4) The Importance of the Japan - Russia Network

- HSCS will realize the shortest route with minimum round trip time between Japan, Russia and Europe.
- HSCS will increase the worldwide cable redundancy.
