

<Scope of Assembly>

- 1. Origin: Japan, Asia Pacific Region (Korea/China etc.) and Europe
- 2. Destination: Russia, CIS countries, European Countries
- * Reverse direction is also included into our scope.
- Role of Parties

RZD: Support the container transportation of the above scope.

Russkaya Troyka: Actual transportation arrangement based on the Agency Agreement with Mitsui.

Mitsui: Sales to customers.

Agency Agreement < Russkaya Troyka and Mitsui >

- Agency Agreement to cover actual International Intermodal transportation by TSR.
- Scope of work is to concentrate on provision of the Block Train Service.

Gradual Approach of the Block Train Composition based on Japanese Customer Demands

Phase1) Utilize the Current Block Train of Russkaya Troyka. (weekly service to Moscow)


(Basically composed with Chinese and Korean Cargoes. Booking can be accepted from 1 Container.)

Phase2) Compose "All Japan Block Train" to Moscow and St.Petersburg.

- To Moscow: Cargo is mainly from Consumer-Electronics Manufacturers
- To St.Petersburg: Cargo is mainly from Car Manufacturers

Phase3) To any other destination depending on Customer Demand.

- Destination other than Moscow and St.Petersburg. (For both East/West bound)
- To Middle/East European area (For both East/West bound)



Mitsui's Various Logistic Activities

Mitsui's activity of other fields related to TSR

- A) Supply of high value infrastructure to Russia: such as supply of Rails.
- B) Locomotive and Wagon Lease in Europe: Mitsui has No.1 share in Europe in the area of lease of wagons through acquisition of Siemens Locomotive Lease Business Unit.
- C) Local Joint Ventures: Various Investments in Russia, such as Sakhalin 2 etc. Cargo information useful for the achievement of All Japan Concept can be obtained though JVs and its network.

Also we foresee possibility of developing any other infrastructure business, based on our experience in Asia.
