






Why Cooperation in GLONASS is Important?

Benefits of combined GPS+GLONASS navigation

- Reliable positioning even if one of the systems is down (like GPS was during military operations in Iraq)
 - Future steps combined solutions, using 3 or more navigation systems: Europe's Galileo, Japan's QZSS
- More stable performance in locations with restricted visibility
- Navigation market revenues are expected to reach €60B by 2010, and €200B by 2011





SPIRIT Navigation Offering

DuoStar baseband software is the basis for a baseband chip or hardware GPS+GLONASS receiver design

- Complete, reliable, already deployed product
- Usage of both worldwide navigation systems: GPS and GLONASS


